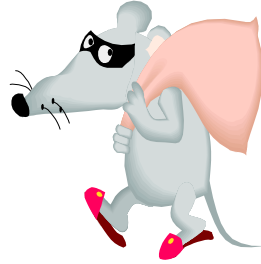
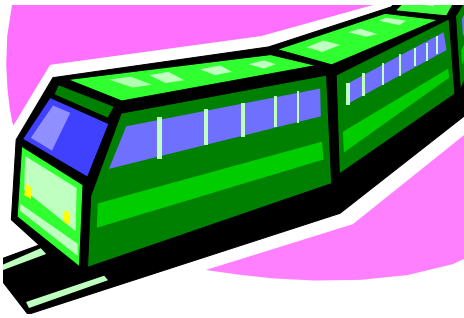


Who should pay for Sound Transit Parking? The City is coming after us to pay for Light Rail's parking problem.
