YOUNG ADULTS in TECH

El Centro de la Raza (ECDLR) is excited to announce that we are currently enrolling participants for our fourth cohort of the Young Adults in Tech (YAT) program. The program provides an 8-week training in Basic Coding with HTML, Java, and CSS, as well as Salesforce Administrator training with the opportunity to become a certified Salesforce Administrator. The program is offered to young adults in the greater Seattle area with barriers to entry in the employment system. Salesforce Administrator certification can lead to living wage jobs in the technology sector. **Young Adults in Tech provides job readiness training, employment assistance, money management and financial literacy skills, and an internship in the student's area of interest.**

We are looking for young adults, ages 16-24, who are out of school and interested in tech!

Upon enrollment in YAT, participants will meet individually with staff to complete a thorough intake assessment, identify their current needs and create an Individual Employment Plan. The assessment will help inform how the program can best serve the participant. The main components of the YAT program are summarized below.

Job Readiness Training: Young adults will participate in an 8-week intensive technology training course in Basic Coding and Salesforce, a cloud-based customer relationship management database, soft skill training, and pre-employment preparation.

Money Management: Participants will receive financial literacy education that covers money management topics, from banking basics to understanding credit and much more.

Employment Assistance: Each participant will receive one-on-one career coaching throughout the program, as well as ongoing contact with internship sites and employers to monitor progress and offer support.

Supportive Services: Participants will have access to ECDLR programs and supportive services to address various barriers they may face.

One-on-One Assistance from an education advocate assisting in navigating the complex systems of higher education and financial aid.

Internships and Job Placement: Our goal will be to prepare young adults to enter into internships or job placement opportunities with local nonprofits and businesses who use Salesforce in their day-to-day operations.
