 - Create the groundwork for a culturally relevant small business accelerator initiative.
 - Support the Sharks on the Beach event and Art Installation idea
 - Local investment in entrepreneurship/leadership opportunities
- Jobs and Economic Access Coordination (\$5 out of \$200)
 - o Jobs and community Board. Especially for youth.
