Welcome! You have taken the first step toward becoming a RecTech Summer Intern. By completing this application, you are expressing your interest in the program and learning important job skills that will help you become more employable in the future. This letter will help you learn more about the opportunities available to you during this upcoming summer as well as explain our expectations of our applicants and interns. OVERVIEW: There are three different RecTech Summer Internship programs; this application applies to all programs. Please make rank the programs in the order of your preference on the application. Digital Darkroom and Photojournalism @ Delridge Community Center, 4501 Delridge Way SW, Seattle, 98106

July 12 – August 26; Mondays – Thursdays, 1:30 PM – 5:30 PM

This intensive seven-week RecTech internship will provide an overview of the digital imaging process and cover the basics of photo-journalism. Interns will learn digital photography basics and survey Photoshop applications. They will explore the digital darkroom and learn tools for image manipulation that have artistic as well as commercial digital media applications. Interns will learn how to collaborate and work as a team as they photograph Seattle events this summer and write short articles to accompany their photography. Their articles will be published online along with their photography. Student work will be exhibited at a final gallery show at the Photographic Center NW. Participants who successfully complete the program earn a \$599 stipend and 15 hours of service learning credits.

Video Production @ Garfield Community Center, 2323 East Cherry St, 98122

July 12 – August 26; Mondays – Thursdays, 1:00 PM – 5:00 PM

Imagine yourself this summer behind a camera or holding a microphone, writing a script or acting in a scene, all the while giving back to your community, and having some serious FUN! For seven short weeks we will dive into an intensive series of workshops in video production, theater, and creative writing. Edit, light, shoot, direct, write, act, interview, we will explore it all. *Participants who successfully complete the program earn a \$599 stipend and 15 hours of service learning credits.*

Do you want to work on websites? Communicate your ideas across the globe! Did you know that you can make money doing it? In this program you will learn web design, graphic design, HTML and interactive animations. You will have the opportunity to work with professional programs such as Photoshop for image editing, Dreamweaver for web page creation, Illustrator for logos and buttons and Flash for animation. Final project will be to work on a website for a local nonprofit or a site for an issue of public interest that you feel passionate about. *Participants who successfully complete the program earn a \$599 stipend and 15 hours of service learning credits.*

PLEASE NOTE: Before you submit a completed application to become a RecTech Intern, please read all the information below and make sure that this is a good fit for your interests, your schedule, and your access to transportation. To receive the stipend and service learning hours (if your internship includes service learning hours), interns must complete all hours and additional commitments as stated in this application.

Many youth from around Seattle will also apply for the program, so make sure that your application stands out among the very best. Please answer all questions completely. If you have any questions, please call or email the contact person on the application. We will not review incomplete applications.

Please note that you will not be judged on your technology skills, however it is important for you to answer these questions honestly as they are a way for us to get to know our participants. There are no right answers to the questions, so be honest about yourself.

Based on the applications we receive, a group of candidates will be chosen and invited to an interview. The interview will be your opportunity to shine and to tell us anything we might not have learned from your

application. Our interviewers will ask you question about yourself, your experience, and your interest in becoming a RecTech Intern. You will want to arrive prepared, energized, and on time. From the interviews, we will invite the incoming class of 2010 interns.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 14-18 years of age;
- Will enroll in high school during the 2010-11 school year or graduated during 2010;
- Skills in computer and Internet basics and common software applications **or desire to learn these skills;** and
- Good interpersonal skills including verbal communication and the desire to work with others.

EXPECTATIONS: Participants will be self-motivated, punctual, enthusiastic, open-minded and willing to work with others. We expect that participants will work safely, think positively, and put forth his/her best effort. Attendance is mandatory at all scheduled activities. Anyone who misses a meeting or presentation without prior notice forfeits his/her position. If for some reason an intern is running late or is absent from a scheduled day, it is required that the student contact the site leader. **IF YOU THINK YOU WILL MISS MORE THAN 2 SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES BECAUSE OF SPORTS OR OTHER PERSONAL ENGAGEMENTS, PLEASE DO NOT APPLY FOR THIS PROGRAM.** Be sure to review the dates and times of your program to ensure it fits your schedule.

TRANSPORTATION: You are responsible for your own transportation. Directions and bus schedules are available upon request. If field trips are scheduled during the day, bus tokens will be provided or students will be transported in city of Seattle vans by approved van drivers who have completed the city of Seattle's defensive driving classes.
